To serve our community better, in coordination with the <u>Michigan Occupational Safety and Health Administration - Consultation Education and Training Division</u>, Michigan Escape Games has prepared a safety response plan.

## Safety changes and improvements include but are not limited to:

- We are separating groups at the entrances by bringing groups into separate lobbies. Signs are posted at the entryways to indicate which lobby to enter based on the room booked.
- Each lobby is then divided with barriers to keep groups separated for social distancing.
- Group sizes are limited to 10 patrons or less per current Michigan orders.
- Groups must have an established appointment booking pre-arranged.
- Overall capacity is reduced to decrease social interaction in the common areas and lobby.
- Introduction rooms/areas are separated from the other public areas and sanitized between groups. Groups shall not be 'mixed' during their introduction and safety videos.
- Signage in the common has been placed to help groups social distance in the common areas.
- Participants and employees shall wear face coverings while in the public areas of the building. This includes lobby spaces, hallways and restrooms.
- Employees shall clean/sanitize control room computers/areas upon swapping game hosts and sanitize hands upon entering/leaving control room areas.
- Employees shall be screened for illness/exposure risk as they arrive for their shift and be sent home if there has been significant exposure or, required to return/stay home if showing symptoms.
- Hand-sanitizing stations are positioned in the lobby areas as well as near the entrance/exits of the game rooms.
- Participants may be verbally screened upon entry. Participants may also be temperature screened with a non-contact device and those with a fever of 100.4 or higher will be denied entry.
- Participants are required to reschedule their appointment if members of their group are symptomatic or test positive for CoVid-19. Or, substitute players are allowed.
- Common areas, sign-in tablets, commonly touched surfaces and restrooms will be cleaned during open hours as well as at the end of shift.
- Escape Game rooms shall be cleaned and commonly touched surfaces sanitized between each group of players.
